

Human Factors Recurrent workshop

Objective:

In the context of Human Factors to refresh and give the participants possibility to reflect and discuss the small nuances, which makes the difference between 'a normal operation' and 'an abnormal operation'.

After the workshop the participants will be able to observe human factors deviations of their own environment.

Target population:

Persons from commercial aviation and mainly from the front lines of aircraft maintenance, ground handling or flight operations.

The workshop can be customized to suit your organizational requirements.

Presentation:

Duration: 3-4 hours

Participants: Minimum 10 maximum 25

The participants must have personal experience from aviation and must have participated in a Human Factors basic course.

The program comprises stand up presentation by means of a power point, video clips, small case studies, and challenges of participants.

The workshop focuses on operations where the persons are in transition from 'being in control' into 'loss of control'. In respect to this, emphasis on the importance of knowledge of and awareness of 'human factors latent condition' and the state of the human mind, when the situation changes is discussed.

Small discussions and questions & answers are a part of the workshop and the participants are welcome and encouraged to contribute with own experience.
